- 1. Open a web browser.



# Navigating the Advisor Dashboard



### **Dashboard Overview**

- 1. UNC Charlotte ID Field: Search bar to enter Student ID.
- 2. Search Button: Loads student's grade replacement data.
- 3. Log Out Button: Ends session securely.
- 4. Home Button: Returns the user to a blank homepage.

## **Student Search**

From the advisor dashboard,

- 1. Enter the student's UNC Charlotte ID (#80) in the UNC Charlotte ID field
- 2. Search to load the student's grade replacement data



- 4. Review the grade replacement summary for the selected student. You can use this to confirm eligibility at a glance and to advise students on remaining options.
  - a. Students are allowed to replace the grade in up to **two courses** (up to 8 credit hours) taken during their undergraduate studies at Charlotte.
    - i. Grade Replacements: Two courses allowed
      - The Allowed column indicates the two allowed grade replacements.
      - 2. The Used column indicates the number of courses used for grade replacement.
      - 3. The Remaining column indicates the number of remaining courses that can be used for grade replacement.
    - ii. Credit Hours: Eight credit hours allowed
      - The Allowed column indicates the eight credit hours allowed grade replacements.
      - 2. The Used column indicates the number of credit hours used for grade replacement.
      - 3. The Remaining column indicates the number of remaining credit hours that can be used for grade replacement.

b. **NOTE**: If a lecture + co-requisite lab are replaced in the same term, it counts as one grade replacement; hours used reflect the combined credits.



- 5. Review the Grade Replacement transactions for the specific student. You will be able to view each grade replacement for the selected student and its status.
  - a. Status Date: Date of the grade replacement status
  - b. Submitted Date: Date and time of the transaction
  - c. Count: Does the Grade Replacement count in the allowed amount
  - d. **Previous Course**: Grade Replacement course that is currently in the student's academic history and is being repeated.
  - e. **Current Course**: Course the student is registered for to replace the grade of the previous course.




# Grade Replacement Status Definitions:

Status	Definition
Eligible for Grade Replacement	The course is eligible for Grade Replacement but has not been selected.
Processed	Grade Replacement has been applied to this past course.
Pending Processing	The course has been selected for Grade Replacement. Grade Replacement will be applied to this course at the end of the term after final grade is received.
Topics Course - Pending Review	You have requested to use Grade Replacement on a Topics Course. This selection is pending administrative review to ensure that both tackings were the same course content.
Cancelled	You opted out of this Grade replacement selection, or it was administratively cancelled on your behalf.
Replacement Denied	Your Grade Replacement selection was administratively denied.
Topics Course - Review Denied	Your request to use Grade Replacement on a Topics Course was administratively denied. This is likely due to the fact that the two courses differed substantively in content.
Course Withdrawn	You have withdrawn from this course. Grade Replacement could not be applied due to your withdrawal. One of your two Grade Replacements was used on this course.  Note: If you need to withdraw from a course which has been selected for Grade Replacement, be sure to opt out of (cancel) your pending Grade Replacement selection before your withdrawal from the course. That way you will preserve that Grade Replacement for future use.
Old Policy - Display Only	The Grade Replacement occurred under a past Grade Replacement policy.
